

## **SCDRO ISSUES HOUSING AWARD LETTERS FOR OCTOBER 2015 STORM**

**Columbia, S.C., January 18, 2017** – The South Carolina Disaster Recovery Office (SCDRO) released seven award letters last week to citizens for the repair or replacement of homes affected by the October 2015 Storm, bringing the total number of award letters released to 17. Award letters notify citizens that they have been accepted into the program. The letter also lists the next steps the citizen must take to move forward.

Once approved, it is up to the citizen to decide if he or she will participate in the program. SCDRO protects the personal information of the citizens we serve and will release only the county and zip code for households served by the program.
