

SCDRO APPLICATION PROCESS

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

- Homeowners who meet the low income HUD guidelines
- Priority of assistance:
 - Income Level (extremely low to low)
 - Disability (any family member)
 - Elderly (65 and over)
 - Children (5 years old and under)
- All applicants must meet:
 - State and Federal Guidelines
 - Pass an Environmental Review
 - Pass a review of previously received storm funds
 - Demonstrate a need to participate in the program

HOW DO I APPLY? / CONTACT US

- Application intake ended on **April 30, 2017**

WHAT DOCUMENTATION DO I NEED TO PROVIDE? (For all household members)

- **GOVERNMENT ISSUED ID** (only one form required)
 - Driver's License
 - Passport
 - Military ID
 - Certificate of Naturalization or Permanent Resident Card
 - Birth Certificate
- **PROOF OF INCOME** (18 yrs. +)
 - 2015 Tax Return OR
 - 2015 W2 or 3 Most Recent Paystubs
 - Unemployment Award Letter
 - Pension/Annuity Letter
 - Social Security Benefit Letter
 - VA Benefit Letter
- **PROOF OF DISABILITY** (If Disabled; Only one form required)
 - Social Security or VA Letter
 - Parking Placard Registration
 - Statement from your Doctor
 - Disability ID or Visible Handicap
- **INSURANCE**
 - Homeowner's Insurance Policy Number
 - Flood Insurance Policy Number
- **WHAT HOMES ARE ELIGIBLE?**
 - You must have owned and occupied your home at the time of the storm
 - You must currently own your home
 - You must have unrepaired storm related damage to a single family home or single family rental unit
 - Home must be in an eligible county
