

# Does your home still have damage from the historic October 2015 Flood?

The South Carolina Disaster Recovery Office is introducing the October 2015 **Storm Recovery Program intended to repair or reconstruct Single-Family Housing and Single-Family Rental units** affected by the October 5, 2015 flood and rain event that still have unserved damage.

This new program is specifically **designed to assist** the extremely low, very low and low income South Carolinian's who require assistance in the repair, replacement, or reconstruction of their homes damaged by the October 2015 Storm.

The program expects to serve approximately 1500 low income homeowners with the priority of assistance focused on the extremely low income, elderly, disabled, and families with children 5 years old or younger in the household.

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

- Homeowners who meet the low income HUD guidelines
- Priority of assistance:
  - Income Level (extremely low to low)
  - Disability (any family member)
  - Elderly (65 and over)
  - Children (5 years old and under)

All applicants must meet State and Federal guidelines and pass an environmental review. Applicants must also pass a review of previously received storm funds and show a need to participate in the program.

**PROOF OF INCOME (18+ years old)**

- Driver's License
- Passport
- Military ID
- Certificate of Naturalization or Permanent Resident Card
- Birth Certificate
- 2015 Tax Return OR
  - 2015 W2 or 3 Most Recent Paystubs
  - Unemployment Award Letter
  - Pension/Annuity Letter
  - Social Security Benefit Letter
  - VA Benefit Letter



**PROOF OF DISABILITY (if disabled)**



**INSURANCE**

- Social Security or VA Letter
- Parking Placard Registration
- Statement from your Doctor
- Disability ID or Visible Handicap
- Homeowner's Insurance Policy Number
- Flood Insurance Policy Number

## WHAT HOMES ARE ELIGIBLE?

- You must have owned and occupied your home at the time of the storm
- You must currently own your home
- You must have unrepaired storm related damage to a single family home or single family rental unit
- Home must be in an eligible county
